This is personal information that you have supplied to us which we use only to contact you about membership, news and events, our website or the Bulletin: it is never passed to anybody outside the CLHF committee without your explicit permission. Occasionally, we may contact you with news of outside events: if you would prefer not to receive these emails please contact membership@clhf.org.uk as you can be placed on a restricted mailing list.

Payments are recorded for membership, event bookings, donations and sales, the date banked and that a receipt has been sent.

As Membership Secretary, I keep a list of when & where your Society meets, your Society's website address and current membership/visitor fees. Your membership numbers help us assess our overall membership number, and your Society's meeting details help me to maintain the Events Diary on our website, www.clhf.org.uk.

All of the above information is kept on spreadsheets on a password protected laptop. Hard copy – e.g. membership & booking forms – is destroyed once the details have been transferred to the computer.

For practical reasons (in case of query by you), your contact details are kept for two years, the current year and the year before. If there has not been a response from you within that time, your record will be deleted.
